ORDER ADOPTING 2026 MONO CO. BAIL SCHEDULE

Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1269b(c) it is the duty of the Superior Court Judges in each county to prepare, adopt, and annually revise a uniform countywide schedule of bail for all bailable felony offenses and for all misdemeanor offenses and infraction offenses except Vehicle Code infractions. In adopting a bail schedule for felony offenses, the judges shall consider the seriousness of the offense charged, and any aggravating or enhancing factors. The purpose of bail is to ensure an arrestee appears in court and to reduce the risk to public and victim safety. Article [], section 12 of the California Constitution entitles most arrestees to release on bail pending trial. The Constitution prohibits excessive bail, and the United States Supreme Court held in *United States v. Salerno* (1987) that "in our society liberty is the norm, and detention prior to trial is the carefully limited exception."

3 The purpose of this bail schedule is to set the amount of bail upon which a person
4 arrested without a warrant may be released from custody prior to their first appearance in
5 court, and to provide guidance for the setting of bail upon the issuance of an arrest warrant
6 pursuant to Penal Code section 815a. Penal Code section 1270.1 prohibits the release of an
7 arrestee on bail
8 in an amount that is either more or less than the amount set in this bail schedule for the
9 offenses listed in Penal Code Section 1270.1(a)(1) -(4) until a hearing has been held in open
10 court.

12 However, a judge or magistrate, pursuant to Penal Code Section 1269c, may with respect to
13 a bailable felony or misdemeanor offense of violating a domestic violence restraining order,
14 increase bail without a hearing, provided an oral or written declaration of facts justifying an
15 increase in the bail amount is presented under penalty of perjury by a sworn peace officer.


16 At and after a defendant's first appearance in court, the amount of bail, if any, shall be in
17 the amount fixed by the judge at the time of the appearance. (Penal Code § 12696(6).) Any bail
18 set at the time of an appearance in court shall comply with Penal Code Section 1275, with the
19 law set forth in *In Re Humphrey* (2021) 11 Cal.5th 135, and Penal Code Section 1203.25(c) for
20 probation violations.



22 When a defendant is booked on, or charged with, two or more offenses, bail shall be set 20
23 in the amount for the charge having the highest bail. If the defendant is charged with crimes
24 against multiple victims or on separate dates, or where separate sex acts have been alleged to
25 have been committed against the same person, bail shall be set for each offense charged. Bail
26 shall also be added for any applicable enhancement alleged.

1 Following a discussion with the Mono County Sheriff and Mono County District
2 Attorney, the Superior Court Judges of the Mono County Superior Court adopt the 2026 Mono
3 County Superior Court Bail Schedule. The bail amount for Felony offenses is set forth in
4 Attachment 'A.'" The bail amount for Misdemeanor offenses is set forth in Attachment "B."
5 This Order shall remain in full force and effect unless until modified by further Order of
6
7 the Court.

ATTACHMENT A

MONO COUNTY BAIL SCHEDULE FOR FELONY OFFENSES

The attached Bail Schedule effective January 1, 2026, is approved by the Judges of the Mono County Superior Court pursuant to Penal Code Section 1269b(c).

FELONIES - See attached schedule from previously used bail schedule, as modified. Any felony not listed in the attached schedule shall have bail set in the amount of \$20,000.

Any violation of felony probation pursuant to Penal Code Section 1203.2 shall have bail set in the amount of \$ 10,000 for informal probation, \$20,000 for formal probation, or as set in an Order summarily revoking probation issued by the Court at the request of the Probation Department or the District Attorney's Office.
